Parish Income fell by 56% from 2019 to 2021, predominantly due to COVID-19. Although the impact of Covid-19 reduced income, the parish has continued to provide ongoing support to the faith community at a time when the need for such support was greater than ever. The overall parish debt stands at €94k approx. Huge thanks to all involved with the fundraising and to everyone for their commitment to the Parish Weekly Envelopes or annual contribution which all contributes to reducing the debt. Fr. Maladen Gardovic, a priest of the Serbian Orthodox Church is renting the Parochial House (this rent is used to also pay off the debt.) which the Diocese has offered as an ecumenical gesture while he ministers to his Orthodox community throughout Ireland. On carrying out an annual inspection of the churches, damage to the stained-glass window in the gallery of Donore church depicting the nativity of Our Lady, was discovered. You may have noticed it has since been restored and expenses covered by our insurance cover. Storm glazing of the other windows will be carried out to help alleviate condensation issues which can cause further damage from moisture retention. The church sacristy also has structural issues resulting from rain damage which we hope to get rectified in the coming months. You will notice some potholes on the way into Donore church carpark have recently been patched up. It is hoped to carry out some more enhancing works at the entrance in the coming year. The basket Offertory Collection at Mass assists with the day to day parish expenditure. The weekly Parish Envelope Development Fund is an essential source to carry out the necessary work to maintain the parish facilities to the standard required to meet the needs of our faith community. There is also the Charitable Donations scheme via the Revenue which parishioners can avail of for yearly donations of €250 and above. Details regarding this scheme can be obtained from Caroline in the Parish Office, along with the weekly Parish Envelopes and Direct Debit details. We express our gratitude for all that has been given and for your continued support.

MASS FOR THE SICK On Saturday 25th June in St. Cianán's we will celebrate Mass for the Sick. Please make arrangements for bringing your family members or neighbours who are housebound and unable to frequently attend Mass. Anyone who is burdened by illness or old age is welcome to join with us for this Mass during which the laying on of hands and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be celebrated. *After the Mass and the anointing there will be refreshments.
