As we continue our spiritual journey of Lent, we realise how blessed we are in this part of the world. The annual Lenten sacrifices or penance we undertake are always an expression of our gratitude for the love and mercy received from Our Father in Heaven. We offer our Lenten prayer, fasting and almsgiving especially for the peoples of Ukraine and the surrounding countries. Please God the atrocity of war may cease and peace prevail. During this season of Lent aside an extra bit of time for prayer, daily Mass, or Eucharistic Adoration. Maybe set up a sacred space/altar in your home with the Bible at the centre and use the Trocaire Box as a visible reminder of how fortunate we are and of what we can share with those whose needs are greater. And of course we are called to give up some favourite foods/sweets or even T.V., iPad or Facebook time as a way of fasting! Remember too that as Catholics we are asked to abstain from meat every Friday and if possible every Wednesday, so perhaps you might also consider keeping this practice over the weeks of Lent! Fr.
