DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY The significance of Divine Mercy Sunday came about through the revelations the Lord Jesus made to Sr. Faustina. She was a nun in Poland a century ago who bore testimony to these revelations, which in time were authenticated and interpreted in the light of what the people of that country experienced with World War 11 and the Soviet era. Pope St. John Paul himself came to know about Sr. Faustina and like so many in Poland found devotion to the sacred image of the Divine Mercy which she was asked by the Lord to share. Indeed such devotion has spread around the world and especially so in our country. The message of Divine Mercy resonated and the recitation of the 3 o'clock prayer has become

a popular expression of trust in the Lord. In the great Jubilee Year 2000 Sr. Faustina was canonised as the first saint of the New Millennium and the Second Sunday after Easter dedicated as Divine Mercy Sunday. Five years later Pope John Paul died on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday! The beautiful Shrine of Divine Mercy is in Kraków, Poland, and there the World Youth Day was celebrated in the special Jubilee Year of Mercy 2016 by Pope Francis and over 3 million young people from around the world. Not far from the shrine is the memorial to the terrible holocaust of Aschwitz and what evil can do in our world. Let us continue to pray for Mercy and seek the pierced hands and side of the Risen Lord to protect and bless us and the whole world. As Pope St. John Paul said in the canonisation homily, "What will the years ahead bring us? What will our future on earth be like? We are not given to know. However, it is certain that in addition to new progress there will unfortunately be no lack of painful experiences. But the light of divine mercy, which the a Lord in a way wished to return to the world through Sr. Faustina's charisms will illumine the way for the men and women of the third millennium." Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world - For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
