MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS FOR WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY ASCENSION SUNDAY 2022

"Dear Brothers and Sisters, [] We all have ears, but many times even those with perfect hearing are unable to hear another person. In fact, there is an interior deafness worse than the physical one. Indeed, listening concerns the whole person, not just the sense of hearing. The true seat of listening is the heart. Though he was very young, King Solomon proved himself wise because he asked the Lord to grant him a "listening heart" (cf. 1 Kings 3:9). Saint Augustine used to encourage listening with the heart (corde audire), to receive words not outwardly through the ears, but spiritually in our hearts: "Do not have your heart in your ears, but your ears in your heart". Saint Francis of Assisi exhorted his brothers to "incline the ear of the heart". Therefore, when seeking true communication, the first type of listening to be rediscovered is listening to oneself, to one's truest needs, those inscribed in each person's inmost being. And we can only start by listening to what makes us unique in creation: the desire to be in relationship with others and with the Other. We are not made to live like atoms, but together."
