Holy Week begins next weekend with the celebration of Palm Sunday and the commemoration of Our Lord's entry into Jerusalem. This is our first public celebration since 2019 due to the terrible pandemic! The Liturgy for Mass will begin as prescribed outdoors (weather permitting). Please bring a branch of evergreen 'palm' with you, some palm will also be provided in the church porches, along with dried palm crosses.

The Donore 11am Mass will begin at 10:45am in the cemetery around the "altar" for the First Part of the Liturgy, followed by the procession with the blessed palms down to the church. Those unable to participate in the procession are asked to gather with their palm branches in the church for 10:45am.

The Rossnaree 6:30pm Vigil Mass will begin in the church yard outside the front door.

THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE (CONFESSION)

Congratulations to the children and their families who celebrated the joy of God's forgiveness in making their first Confession today (Saturday).

Never hesitate in seeking the grace of this Sacrament, especially if things on your mind are weighing you down. Seek God's sacramental forgiveness for our sins and go to confession. It does not matter how long it is since your last confession nor what you have to say! God's love and mercy expressed in this Sacrament is unconditional; He only waits for you to restore your relationship with him and those around you. Think about going to Confession for Easter!





UKRAINE We continue our prayers for an end to the war imposed by Russia on Ukraine. We implore the intercession of Pope St. John Paul II co-patron saint of Europe.
