FEAST OF ST. BRIGID, 1ST **FEBRUARY** To mark the Feast of St. Brigid, Thursday 1St February, it would be great if parishioners who have some free time could make a few extra crosses to bring to this Mass in Duleek or Donore for blessing and distribution. It is an Irish tradition for such crosses to be placed in farm sheds to protect the animals from any harm and to seek God's blessing upon all involved in farming as we in Ireland mark the beginning of springtime!

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD/CANDLEMAS DAY 2ND FEBRUARY Blessing of candles for use during Masses in our churches and at the Vigil or Wakes during the year and other occasions of family prayer in the home. Please bring any candles you want blessed to the 9am Mass in Donore. After this Feast Day the cribs are taken down. It is also World Day for Consecrated Life when we acknowledge and pray for the religious sisters, religious brothers, lay men and women who have taken consecrated vows in the Church, remembering especially those from our parish.



YOUTH MEET & PRAYER GATHERING (+18 years) will take place in St. Mary's Church, Drogheda at 7:30pm on Friday 2nd February, The Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. 

PARISH ENVELOPE BOXES 2024/25 The new Parish Envelope Boxes begin this weekend. We are most grateful for the



kind assistance the volunteer distributors provided in recent weeks. Again a huge thanks to everyone for your constant support to both the Development Fund and the Mass Offertory (basket) Collection.
