Pope Francis speaking last Sunday at the end of the Angelus in St. Peter's Square, Rome: "And while there are many people in the world who suffer due to disasters and hunger, we continue to produce and sell weapons and burn resources fueling wars, large and small. This is an outrage that the international community should not tolerate, and it contradicts the spirit of brotherhood of the Olympic Games that have just begun. Let us not forget, brothers and sisters: war is defeat! Today we celebrate World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, on

the theme "Do not cast me off in my old age" (cf. Psalm 71:9). The abandonment of the elderly is indeed a sad reality to which we must not grow accustomed. For many of them, especially in these summer days, loneliness risks becoming a difficult burden to bear. The Day calls us to listen to the voice of the elderly who say, "Do not abandon me!", and to answer, "I will not abandon you!". Let us strengthen the alliance between grandparents and grandchildren, between young people and the elderly. Let us say "no" to the loneliness of the elderly! Our future depends a great deal on how grandparents and grandchildren learn to live together. Let us not forget the elderly! And a round of applause for all the grandparents, all of them!" Every Friday for the summer grandparents are invited to bring their grandchildren, living close by or staying for sleep over or holidays, to the morning 9:30am Mass in our parish. Fr. Mark and Fr. Anthony will focus upon this sacred bond between the generations.
