THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS is a liturgical feast celebrated on the Friday after Corpus Christi. The devotion to the heart of Jesus has Christ's unconditional love at its centre exemplified in the blood and water which poured forth from Christ's heart in his sacrifice on the cross. St. Marguerite Marie Alacoque, a 17th-century French nun and mystic, helped spread devotion to the Sacred Heart through her visions in which Christ expressed his desire to reveal his loving heart to mankind. This month marks the conclusion of the 350th Anniversary celebrations since Jesus made this revelation at Paray-Le-Monial, France. As the late Pope Francis remarked; "Friday we will celebrate the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Do not be afraid to present to him all the intentions of our suffering humanity, its fears, its miseries. May this Heart, full of love for all, give everyone hope and trust. [] I invite you to discover the riches that are hidden in the Heart of Jesus, to learn to love your neighbour." During the recent Parish Pilgrimage to the Shrines of France we prayed for the families of our Parish Faith Communities and implored the blessings of the Sacred Heart upon all. O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in Thee.

THE JUBILEE PRAYER Father in heaven, may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother, and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.
